



Job Posting: Music Faculty – Violin Teacher

The Kamloops Symphony Music School is looking to add a new **Violin Teacher** to our faculty, starting in the Fall of 2022.

The enthusiastic individual or individual(s) will provide classical-based private instruction for both existing and new motivated violin students of all ages and abilities on a part-time, as needed basis.

About the Kamloops Symphony Music School

The Kamloops Symphony Music School (KSMS) is a non-profit music education facility operated by the Kamloops Symphony Society. An important part of the Symphony's mandate is to provide educational opportunities for the citizens of its catchment area. Since 2002, the KSMS has provided opportunities for music education to citizens of the district and given further employment opportunities to local musicians.

Our highly qualified faculty members work with students toward the achievement of their own goals. All students are encouraged to experience the joy of performing in groups and to participate in school recitals and festival competition. We also offer preparation for conservatory examinations and post-secondary entrance auditions.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor of Music degree in Violin or equivalent
- Violin teaching experience
- Performance experience (solo, chamber, orchestral)

Scheduling:

The chosen individual(s) is/are expected to take on approximately 10 existing students from another faculty member (total teaching time approximately 6 hours), as well as new students who express interest, starting in the Fall of 2022. Lessons vary from 30 to 60 minutes, and scheduling can be discussed with the right candidates, although typically take place during the week, between the hours of 3 pm and 8 pm. (Weekends are also possible).

Lesson rates, and corresponding commission rates for teachers can be discussed with KSMS with the suitable candidate(s). Depending on applicants and their desired levels of commitments, more than one candidate could be considered. The candidate(s) is/are expected to teach in-person, but with the occasional online teaching possible pending conditions.

Playing opportunities in the Kamloops Symphony may be possible for the right candidate but are not guaranteed as part of this position. Applicants who wish to be considered for the orchestra should make it known in their application.
